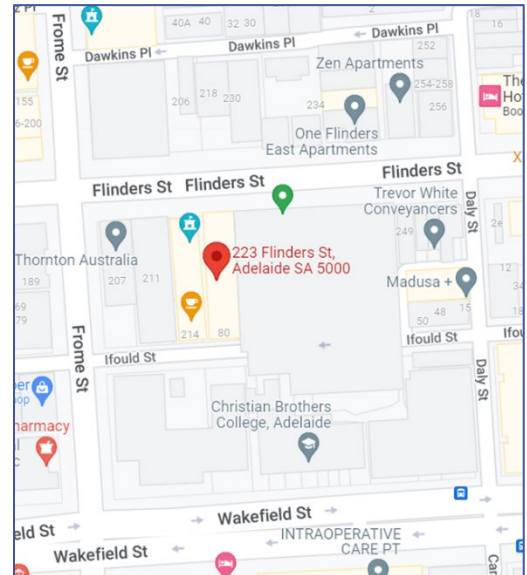

Weekly Gatherings

We gather at 10.30am on Sundays at My Lover Cindi:

223 Flinders St,
Adelaide 5000.

Access is from
Flinders Street.



We are tucked away down this laneway, between two buildings.

The building on the left of the image (the old German Club) is painted black, and the building on the right is exposed brick.



We are about 20 meters down the laneway, on the left.

Note: The laneway is uneven in parts, marked with bright pink tape.

Access

As you go down the laneway, our entrance is the black door on the left.

The doorway is wheelchair access friendly, but only wide enough for one person at a time. Once inside, the path veers to the right.

(The nearest sloped kerb is about 10 meters east of our laneway, in front of the CBC Uniform shop.)



Toilet facilities

Both toilet blocks in the venue are gender neutral.

The toilet near the back has been modified to allow for easier access via wheelchair / mobility aid.

The toilet near the front is designated for kids / parents (because there is less graffiti visible).

Inside the space



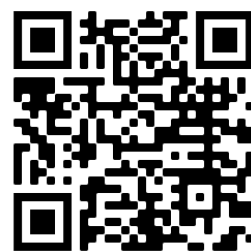
The venue has an open floorplan, with booths and moveable chairs.
